The Tolley Medal

The William Pearson Tolley Medal for Distinguished Leadership in Adult Education was created by resolute action of the Executor Committee of the Board of Trustees of Syracuse University in 1966. The award is focused on an individual but consideration is given to international geographic distribution and to the types of agencies of Adult Education. A committee of the Board of Trustees usually selects the recipient. The medal is usually presented by the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees at a formal reception. The recipient makes a presentation which the University publishes as part of the Medal Series. The Medal was designed by Peter Peining Professor of Art.
